



Lyndhurst redevelopment project should see action in February

Lyndhurst Mayor Joseph Cicero said he spoke Monday with the developers of the project that will result in a Key Bank branch being constructed on the northeast corner of Mayfield and Brainard roads.

The city, in November, received a \$3-million Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund grant from the state which will be used for the environmental cleanup of the land after three buildings are demolished.

"I would imagine that by the end of February everyone in the buildings (tenants) will be out," Cicero said of the Penguin Dry Cleaners/All Brands Vacuums building, and the Mayfield Brainard Professional Building. "Something should be going on after that, the demolition and then the construction."

The project is being developed by WXZ Development Inc. of Fairview Park.
